Teacher Opportunity Grants

Presented by the AHS Class of 1962

The Alliance High School Class of 1962 is pleased to offer grants to provide financial assistance to teachers in Alliance High School in any field of study. Grants are available to enhance knowledge and enthusiasm by engaging in activities relevant to their teaching field. Grants are not primarily intended to fund basic tuition and expenses at a college or university.

The intention is to aid up to \$5000 for activities that will enhance the teacher's classroom effectiveness. Examples might include funding for study or travel abroad, participation in art, music, or dance workshop, internships in the workplace either in United States or foreign countries, to name only a few.

The intention is to annually distribute funds for these awards. Funds will be distributed upon completion of the activity. Application for grants for any fiscal year will be considered after 1 April until 31 March of the next fiscal year. Grants seeking funding for a previous event in a previous fiscal year will not be considered. Priority will be given to those who have not been previous grant recipients. Reapplication is required for possible refunding.

ELIGIBILITY: Teachers in Alliance High School

CRITERIA: Applicants must show determination, enthusiasm, curiosity and ambition

APPLICATION:

1. Brief cover letter stating goals and aspirations
2. Resume, to include school and community activities, awards, employment and travel
3. Other factors that might influence the decision of the grant committee.
